Remember, these sizes are just a place to start. They may not always be accurate given that different brands use different size scales. Having some basic measurements is essential, especially because many costumes for rent are not sized.

| 1 | Neck | Measure around the base of <br> the neck. Add $1 / 2$ " for men's <br> dress shirt sizing. |
| :---: | :---: | :--- |
| 2 | Shirt sleeve | Measure level to the floor from <br> center back between shoulder <br> blades around bent elbow to <br> wrist bone. Add 2-4" for men's <br> dress shirt sizing. |
| 3 | Bicep | Helpful to have for many <br> different body types. |
| 4 | Chest/Bust | Measure around the fullest <br> point level with the floor. |
| 5 | Natural <br> WaistMeasure around the smallest <br> point level lith the floor. Until <br> recently, waistbands were <br> most often worn at the natural <br> waist. |  |
| 6 | Pants Waist | Always falls 3" below natural <br> waist and is helpful to have for <br> modern clothing and men's <br> pants. |
| 7 | Low Hip | Measure around the fullest <br> point of the bum or 9" below <br> natural waist. |
| 8 | Inseam | Remember to add length to <br> account for styling and heel <br> height. The average measure <br> from ankle to floor without <br> shoes is 3". |
