

Costume Designer's Abstract

A designer's abstract is a short explanation of the character and the costume design you have created for the character. It should be one page long and have five paragraphs.

It needs to include the following:

1. an introduction that includes the character and the personality/relevant information about the character.
2. a description of the costume and why it was designed in the specific way it was designed
3. a description of the materials used in the creation of the costume and how they gave the illusion of a real outfit
4. a description of the group's jobs and how each person worked together
5. a conclusion that shows how the costume relates to the character and the play
