Course Description

5. No GUM!!!



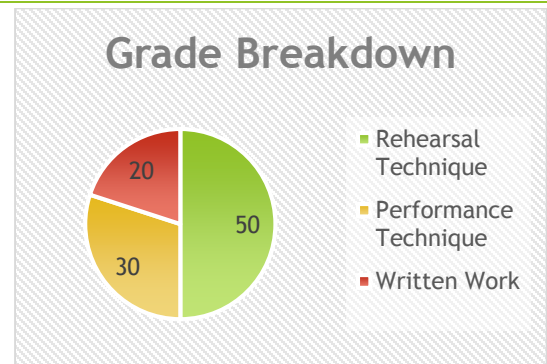
